Pilot Car and Truck Escort Process Pilot Program

Effective Monday, August 3, 2009, ALL trucks 40 feet and over require an escort.

LOADSTAR HOURS OF OPERATION: Loadstar will provide pilot car service -Monday through Friday – 5:30 am to 3:00 pm. Loadstar is available to provide service during the week outside of the core hours and weekends when the service is pre-scheduled through the work request center.
